Flood bulletin as on 1st August, 2013

As on today, 14,700 population in three districts i.e. Dhemaji, Lakhimpur & Golaghat district is being affected by flood. Eight (8) relief camps in Dhemaji district are operational with 2085 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 6 revenue circles & 51 villages. The revenue circles affected are Jonai under Dhemaji district; Majuli, West Jorhat and Teok under Jorhat district; Golaghat under Golaghat district & Nawboicha under Lakhimpur district. A total of 10 villages and 2460 people have been affected in Dhemaji district; 15 villages and 9768 people have been affected in Lakhimpur district & 14 villages and 2472 people have been affected in Golaghat district.

As per CWC report, following rivers are flowing above danger levels- river Brahmaputra at Nematighat (Jorhat) & river Dhansiri (South) at Numaligarh (Golaghat).
