Flood bulletin as on 1st September, 2013

As on today, Dhemaji, Golaghat, Lakhimpur and Hailakandi districts are affected by flood. A total of 10,851 people are affected in these districts in 67 villages of 6 revenue circles. Total one (1) relief camp in Dhemaji is operational with 452 camp inmates.

The revenue circles affected are Jonai, Sisiborgaon & Dhemaji under Dhemaji district, Golaghat under Golaghat district; Subansiri under Lakhimpur district and Algapur under Hailakandi district.

As per CWC reports no rivers are flowing above danger level as on today.
