Flood bulletin as on 3rd August, 2013

As on today, 5173 people in three districts viz. Dhemaji, Jorhat & Golaghat have been affected by flood as per the reports of concerned district administrations. Nine (8) relief camps in Dhemaji district are still operational with 2085 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 5 revenue circles & 35 villages. The revenue circles affected are Jonai and Dhemaji under Dhemaji district; West Jorhat & Teok under Jorhat district and Golaghat under Golaghat district. A total of 18 villages & 2460 people have been affected in Dhemaji district; 12 villages & 1661 people have been affected in Jorhat district; 5 villages & 1052 people have been affected in Golaghat district.

As per CWC report, only river Dhansiri (South) at Numaligarh (Golaghat) is flowing above danger level.
