Flood bulletin as on 03rd October, 2013

As on today, only 06 villages under Jonai Revenue Circles of Dhemaji district are affected by flood with 178 Hecter areas (in Jonai) of cropland under inundation. A total of 670 people in Dhemaji dist. are still remain affected with no relief camps.

As per CWC reports no rivers are flowing above danger level as on today.
