Flood bulletin as on 04th August, 2013

As on today, 4542 people have been affected in three districts viz. Dhemaji, Jorhat & Golaghat district as per the report received from district administration. Total eight (8) relief camps in Dhemaji district are still operational with 2085 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from three (3) revenue circle & 20 villages. The revenue circles affected are Golaghat under Golaghat district; Jonai under Dhemaji district and Jorhat west under Jorhat district. Total of 10 villages & 2460 people in Jonai revenue circle, 8 villages & 1661 people in Jorhat revenue circle and 2 villages & 421 people in Golaghat revenue circle are reported to be affected by flood.

As per CWC reports today, Dhansiri (south) river is flowing above danger level at Nematighat (Golaghat).
