**Flood bulletin as on 4<sup>th</sup> September, 2013**

As on today, 9861 populations in Dhemaji & Lakhimpur district have been affected by flood. In Hailakandi district, only crop areas have been affected. One (1) relief camp in Dhemaji district is continued to be operational with 452 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 5 Revenue Circles & 68 Villages. The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai, Sisiborgaon & Dhemaji under Dhemaji district ; Nowboicha under Lakhimpur district & Algapur under Hailakandi district.

As per CWC report, following rivers are flowing above danger level: river Brahmaputra at Neamatighat & river Jia Bharali at NT Road Xing (Sonitpur).
