**Press Release by Assam State Disaster Management Authority (ASDMA)**

**Flood bulletin as on 5<sup>th</sup> August, 2013**

As on today, 3317 population in two districts i.e. Dhemaji & Jorhat have been affected by flood. Three (3) relief camps in Dhemaji district are still operational with 528 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 4 Revenue Circles & 32 Villages. The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai & Dhemaji under Dhemaji district; West Jorhat under Jorhat district & Golaghat under Golaghat district. A total of 18 Villages and 1656 people have been affected in Dhemaji district & 8 villages and 1661 people have been affected in Jorhat district.

As per CWC report, river Dhansiri (South) is flowing above danger level at Numaligarh (Golaghat).
