Flood bulletin as on 5th September, 2013

As on today, 22397 populations in Dhemaji district have been affected by flood. In Hailakandi district, only crop areas have been affected as reported from the district, while Tinsukia district has reported that population affected is under assessment. No report has been received from Dibrugarh district, though it has telephonically informed that Chabua & Dibrugarh East revenue circle have been affected. One (1) relief camp in Dhemaji district is continued to be operational with 452 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 8 Revenue Circles & 127 Villages. The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai, Sisiborgaon & Dhemaji under Dhemaji district; Chabua & Dibrugarh East under Dibrugarh district; Doomdooma & Tinsukia under Tinsukia district & Algapur under Hailakandi district.

As per CWC report, following rivers are flowing above danger level: river Brahmaputra at Dibrugarh & Neamatighat and river Jia Bharali at NT Road Xing (Sonitpur).
