

**Flood bulletin as on 6<sup>th</sup> September, 2013**

As on today, 145054 populations in 6 districts i.e. Dhemaji , Dibrugarh,Golaghat ,Jorhat,Lakhimpur & Sivasagar district have been affected by flood. In Hailakandi district, only crop areas have been affected as reported from the district, while Tinsukia district has reported that population affected is under assessment. Four (4) relief camps in Dhemaji & Tinsukia district are operational with 1370 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 19 Revenue Circles & 411 Villages. The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai, Sisiborgaon,Gogamukh & Dhemaji under Dhemaji district; Chabua, Dibrugarh East & Dibrugarh West under Dibrugarh district; Bihpuria & Kadam under Lakhimpur district;Dergaon under Golaghat district;Demoow & Sivasagar under Sivasagar district; Doomdooma & Tinsukia under Tinsukia district & Algapur under Hailakandi district and Majuli,Teok,Jorhat West and Jorhat East under Jorhat district.

As per CWC report, following rivers are flowing above danger level: river Brahmaputra at Dibrugarh & Neamatighat and river Jia Bharali at NT Road Xing (Sonitpur).
