Flood bulletin as on 8th August, 2013

As on today, 30163 people in three districts viz. Dhemaji, Jorhat & Golaghat have been affected by flood as per the reports of concerned district administrations. Three (3) relief camps in Dhemaji district (with 528 camp inmates) and twenty (20) camps in Golaghat districts (3570 camp inmates in Bokaghat Rev. Circle and rest population of camp inmates under assessment) are operational.

Flood has been reported from 10 Revenue Circles and 292 villages of the said districts. The Revenue Circles affected are Sissiborgaon, Jonai and Dhemaji under Dhemaji district; West Jorhat & Teok under Jorhat district and Golaghat, Bokaghat, Dergaon, Khumtai & Morongi under Golaghat district. A total of 25 villages & 1656 people have been affected in Dhemaji district; 26 villages & 2153 people have been affected in Jorhat district; 101 villages & 26354 people have been affected in Golaghat district.

As per CWC report, River Jiyabharali at Sonitpur and River Dhansiri (South) at two points viz. Numaligarh & Golaghat are flowing above danger level.
