Flood bulletin as on 09th August, 2013

As on today, 34054 people in Dhemaji, Golaghat & Jorhat districts are affected by flood as per the report of respective district administrations. 3 relief camps in Dhemaji district, 18 in Golaghat district & 2 in Jorhat district are operational with a total of 2954 camp inmates as per the report received.

The revenue circles affected are Dhemaji, Jonai & Sissiborgaon under Dhemaji district; Golaghat, Bokakhat, dergaon, Morongi & Khumtai under Golaghat district; Jorhat West, Titabor & Teok under Jorhat district. A total of 20 villages and 3962 people have been affected in Dhemaji district, 102 villages and 26354 populations have been affected in Golaghat district & 29 villages and 3738 people have been affected in Jorhat district.

As per CWC reports, the Rivers **Dhansiri (south)** at Numaligarh (Golaghat) is flowing above the danger level.
