Flood bulletin as on 10th August, 2013

As on today, 53714 people in Dhemaji, Lakhimpur, Golaghat & Jorhat districts are affected by flood as per the report received from respective district administrations. Three (3) relief camps in Dhemaji Dist. & five (5) in Golaghat Dist. are still operational with a total of 2659 camp inmates as per the report received.

The Revenue Circles affected are Dhemaji, Jonai & Sissiborgaon under Dhemaji district; Golaghat, Bokakhat, Dergaon, Morongi & Khumtai under Golaghat district; Jorhat West, & Teok under Jorhat district and Nowboicha in Lakhimpur district. A total of 21 villages and 3517 people have been affected in Dhemaji district, 105 villages and 32,004 people have been affected in Golaghat district & 19 villages, 2,153 people have been affected in Jorhat district and 19 villages & 16,040 people have been affected as per the report.

According to CWC reports, the Rivers **Dhansiri (south) at** Numaligarh (Golaghat) and River Puthimari in N.H. crossing point in Kamrup (Rural) are flowing above the danger level.
