**Flood bulletin as on 10<sup>th</sup> September, 2013**

As on today, 3,54,731 population in ten districts viz. Barpeta, Chirang, Dhemaji, Jorhat, Golaghat, Lakhimpur, Morigaon, Nagaon, Nalbari & Sonitpur district have been affected by flood as reported from the districts. Seventy Six (76) relief camps in Dhemaji, Nagaon, Morigaon, Nalbari, Golaghat & Sonitpur district are operational with 24,509 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 28 Revenue Circles & 534 villages. The Revenue Circles affected are Barpeta, Baghbor & Kalgachia under Barpeta district; Boitamari & Shrijangram under Bongaigaon district; Bijni under Chirang district; Majuli, Teok under Jorhat district; Jonai, Sissiborgaon & Dhemaji under Dhemaji district; Bihpuria under Lakhimpur district; Koyan & Chamaria under Kamrup district; Kaliabor & Samaguri under Nagaon district; Tihu, Barkhetri & Banekuchi under Nalbari district; Mayong, Laharighat & Bhuragaon under Morigaon district; Tezpur, Gohpur & Halem under Sonitpur district; Dergaon & Bokakhat under Golaghat district & Algapur under Hailakandi district.

As per CWC report, river Brahmaputra is flowing above danger level at Neamatighat, Goalpara & Dhubri.
