**Press Release by Assam State Disaster Management Authority (ASDMA)**

**Flood bulletin as on 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2013**

As on today, 39,529 people in Dhemaji, Lakhimpur, Nagaon, Golaghat & Jorhat districts are affected by flood as per the report received from respective district administrations. Three (3) relief camps in Dhemaji Dist. & Seven (7) in Golaghat Dist. are still operational with a total of 4421 camp inmates as per the report received.

The Revenue Circles affected are Dhemaji, Jonai & Sissiborgaon under Dhemaji district; Golaghat, Bokakhat, Dergaon, Morongi & Khumtai under Golaghat district; Jorhat West, & Teok under Jorhat district and Nowboicha in Lakhimpur district. A total of 21 villages and 1656 people have been affected in Dhemaji district, 86 villages and 26,203 people have been affected in Golaghat district; 23 villages & 750 people have been affected in Jorhat district, 23 villages & 10,300 population have been affected in Lakhimpur district and 2 villages & 620 people have been affected as per the report.

According to CWC reports, **River Dhansiri (south) at Numaligarh (Golaghat)**, **River Beki at Rd. Bridge (Barpeta)**, **River Jia Bharali at N.T. Rd. Crossing (Sonitpur)** and **River Puthimari in N.H. crossing point in Kamrup (Rural)** are flowing above the danger level.
