Flood bulletin as on 12th August, 2013

As on today, 31,935 people in three districts viz. Dhemaji, Jorhat, Lakhimpur, Nagaon & Golaghat have been affected by flood as per the reports of concerned district administrations. Two (2) relief camps each in Golaghat & Nagaon districts with 2096 & 1100 camp inmates are operational. While the total camp inmates in 2 relief camps in Jorhat district are still under assessment as per the report of district administration.

Flood has been reported from 12 Revenue Circles and 127 villages of the said districts. The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai and Dhemaji under Dhemaji district; West Jorhat, Titabor & Teok under Jorhat district; Golaghat, Bokaghat, Dergaon, Khumtai & Morongi under Golaghat district; Nowboicha under Lakhimpur district and Samaguri under Nagaon district. A total of 18 villages & 2511 people have been affected in Dhemaji district; 21 villages & 750 people (only in Titabor circle) have been affected in Jorhat district; 82 villages & 25674 people have been affected in Golaghat district; 04 villages & 1900 people have been affected in Lakhimpur district and 02 villages & 1100 people have been affected in Nagaon district.

As per CWC report, River Dhansiri (South) at Numaligarh (Golaghat), River Beki at Rd. Bridge (Barpeta) and River Puthimari at N.H. Rd. Crossing (Kamrup) are flowing above danger level.
