Flood bulletin as on 13th August, 2013

As on today, 34006 population in six districts i.e. Dhemaji, Lakhimpur, Golaghat, Nagaon, Sonitpur & Jorhat have been affected by flood. Seven (7) relief camps in Golaghat, Nagaon & Jorhat district are operational with 3683 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 15 Revenue Circles & 141 Villages. The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai, Sisiborgaon & Dhemaji under Dhemaji district; West Jorhat & Titabor under Jorhat district, Golaghat, Khumtai, Dergaon & Morongi under Golaghat district; Kadam, Bihpuria & Narayanpur under Lakhimpur district; Samaguri under Nagaon district and Gohpur and Helem under Sonitpur district.

As per CWC report, river Dhansiri (South) is flowing above danger level at two points i.e. Numaligarh & Golaghat.
