Flood bulletin as on 13th September, 2013

As on today, 49,274 population in four districts viz. Dhemaji, Golaghat, Nagaon & Nalbari district have been affected by flood as reported from the districts. In Hailakandi & Kamrup district only crop areas have been affected. Sixteen (16) relief camps in Dhemaji, Nagaon & Golaghat district are operational with 18,095 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 8 Revenue Circles & 74 villages. The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai under Dhemaji district; Nagarbera under Kamrup district; Kaliabor & Samaguri under Nagaon district; Barkhetri under Nalbari district; Dergaon & Bokakhat under Golaghat district & Algapur under Hailakandi district.

As per CWC report, river Brahmaputra is flowing above danger level at Dhubri.
