Flood bulletin as on 14th August, 2013

As on today, 44667 population in six districts i.e. Dhemaji, Lakhimpur, Golaghat, Nagaon, Sonitpur & Jorhat have been affected by flood. Eleven (11) relief camps in Sonitpur, Golaghat, Nagaon & Jorhat district are operational with 1920 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 13 Revenue Circles & 131 Villages. The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai & Dhemaji under Dhemaji district; West Jorhat & Titabor under Jorhat district, Golaghat, Khumtai, Dergaon & Morongi under Golaghat district; Nowboicha & Narayanpur under Lakhimpur district; Samaguri under Nagaon district and Gohpur and Helem under Sonitpur district.

As per CWC report, river Dhansiri (South) is flowing above danger level at Numaligarh.
