**Press Release by Assam State Disaster Management Authority (ASDMA)**

**Flood bulletin as on 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2013**

As on today, Dhemaji, Golaghat, Hailakandi and Kamrup districts are affected by flood in 29 villages of 4 Revenue Circles. However a total of 2,510 people are affected only in the district of Dhemaji, while in rest of the districts only crop areas are affected. Total two (2) relief camps in Dhemaji (Jonai Revenue Circle) are operational with 792camp inmates.

The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai under Dhemaji district, Bokakhat under Golaghat district, Nagarbera under Kamrup district and Algapur under Hailakandi district.

As per CWC reports no rivers are flowing above danger level as on today.
