Flood bulletin as on 15th July, 2013

The flood situation in the State of Assam has improved as compared to yesterday. As on today, Dhemaji, Jorhat and Nagaon districts are still affected by floods. A total of **27752** people are affected in these three districts in 59 villages of 6 revenue circles. Six (6) relief camps in Dhemaji district continue to be operational with 1237 camp inmates. However, 23630 persons in Samgauri Revenue Circle of Nagaon district are taking shelter in 24 temporary shelters.

The revenue circles affected are Dhemaji, Jonai and Sissiborgaon under Dhemaji district; Teok & Majuli under Jorhat district and Samaguri under Nagaon district. A total of 33 villages and 4122 people have been affected in Dhemaji district; 12 villages and 23630 people have been affected in Nagaon district. But, in the 14 villages of Jorhat district only croplands have been submerged but no population have been affected as reported by the district administration.

As per CWC reports the following rivers are still flowing above danger level – **Brahmaputra** at Nematighat (Jorhat), **Brahmaputra** at Dhubri, **Dhansiri** at Numaligarh & **Jia Bharali** at NT Rd. Xing (Sonitpur).
