Flood bulletin as on 15th August, 2013

As on today, 33,563 people in Dhemaji, Lakhimpur, Nagaon, Golaghat & Jorhat districts are affected by flood as per the report received from respective district administrations. Three (3) relief camps in Nagaon Dist. & three (3) in Golaghat Dist. are still operational with a total of 1920 camp inmates as per the report received.

The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai under Dhemaji district; Golaghat, Dergaon, Morongi & Khumtai under Golaghat district; Samaguri under Nagaon district; Jorhat West under Jorhat district and Nowboicha & Narayanpur under Lakhimpur district. A total of 10 villages & 2511 people have been affected in Dhemaji district, 62 villages & 23,045 people have been affected in Golaghat district; 11 villages & 6127 people have been affected in Lakhimpur district and 3 villages & 1880 people have been affected in Nagaon district as per the report. However in Jorhat district only crop areas are reported to be affected in 16 villages.

According to CWC reports, **River Dhansiri (south) at Numaligarh (Golaghat)** is flowing above the danger level.
