Flood bulletin as on 16th August, 2013

As on today, 24693 population in five districts i.e. Dhemaji, Lakhimpur, Golaghat, Nagaon, & Jorhat have been affected by flood. Fifteen (15) relief camps in Nagaon & Dhemaji district are operational with 5068 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 14 Revenue Circles & 99 Villages. The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai & Dhemaji under Dhemaji district; West Jorhat under Jorhat district, Golaghat, Khumtai, Dergaon & Bokakhat under Golaghat district; Narayanpur under Lakhimpur district; Samaguri, Nagaon Sadar, Hojai, Dabaka, Lanka & Kaliabor under Nagaon district.

As per CWC report, river Dhansiri (South) is flowing above danger level at Numaligarh.
