Flood bulletin as on 16th September, 2013

As on today, Dhemaji and Hailakandi districts are affected by flood in 16 villages of 2 Revenue Circles. However a total of 2,510 people are still remain affected in Dhemaji district, while in Hailakandi only crop areas are reported to be affected. Total two (2) relief camps in Dhemaji (Jonai Revenue Circle) are operational with 792camp inmates.

The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai under Dhemaji district and Algapur under Hailakandi district.

As per CWC reports no rivers are flowing above danger level as on today.
