Flood bulletin as on 17th July, 2013

The Flood situation in Assam has improved with three districts (Dhemaji, Jorhat and Nagaon) being affected as on today. The number of affected population has also come down significantly from 31,174 to 10,241 & in Jorhat only crop areas have been affected. Nine (9) relief camps in Dhemaji district are operational with 2078 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 5 revenue circles & 66 villages. The revenue circles affected are Dhemaji, Jonai and Sissiborgaon under Dhemaji district; Majuli under Jorhat district and Samaguri under Nagaon district. A total of 47 villages and 6402 people have been affected in Dhemaji district; 9 villages and 3839 people have been affected in Nagaon district, as reported by the concerned district administrations.

As per CWC reports, river Brahmaputra is flowing above danger level at Nematighat (Jorhat) & river Dhansiri is flowing above danger level at Numaligarh (Golaghat) today at 8AM.
