Flood bulletin as on 17th August, 2013

As on today, 18593 population in five districts i.e. Dhemaji, Lakhimpur, Golaghat, Nagaon, & Jorhat have been affected by flood. Seventeen (17) relief camps in Golaghat, Nagaon & Dhemaji district are operational with 5468 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 13 Revenue Circles & 86 Villages. The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai, Sisiborgaon & Dhemaji under Dhemaji district; West Jorhat under Jorhat district, Golaghat, Khumtai, Dergaon & Bokakhat under Golaghat district; Narayanpur under Lakhimpur district; Samaguri, Nagaon Sadar, Hojai, & Kaliabor under Nagaon district.

As per CWC report, following rivers are flowing above danger level: Dhansiri (South) at Numaligarh, Dikhow at Sibasagar, Desang at Naglamura (Sibasagar) & Kathakhal at Matizuri (Hailakandi).
