Flood bulletin as on 18th July, 2013

The number of affected population as on today in two districts of Assam i.e. Dhemaji & Nagaon are 19,504 & in Jorhat & Lakhimpur district, only crop areas have been affected as reported by the concerned district administrations. Nine (9) relief camps in Dhemaji district are still operational with 2078 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 7 revenue circles & 86 villages. The revenue circles affected are Dhemaji, Jonai, Gogamukh and Sissiborgaon under Dhemaji district, Majuli under Jorhat district, Samaguri under Nagaon district & Naraynpur under Lakhimpur district. A total of 65 villages and 15665 people have been affected in Dhemaji district; 9 villages and 3839 people have been affected in Nagaon district as reported from the districts.

As per CWC report, river Brahmaputra is flowing above danger level at Nematighat (Jorhat) & river Dhansiri is flowing above danger level at Numaligarh (Golaghat) today at 8AM.

North East Space Application Centre (NESAC) has also issued low to moderate flood warning for Dhemaji, Jonai & Sisiborgaon revenue circles of Dhemaji district and North Lakhimpur, Subansiri, Kadam revenue circles of Lakhimpur district, which is valid till 20.00 hrs. of 18th July 2013.
