**Press Release by Assam State Disaster Management Authority (ASDMA)**

**Flood bulletin as on 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2013**

As on today, 38,366 people in Dhemaji, Nagaon & Sivasagar district are affected by flood as per the report received from respective district administrations. In Lakhimpur & Jorhat district, only crops areas have been affected. Total 36 relief camps in Sivasagar, Dhemaji and Nagaon are operational with a total of 15,647 camp inmates, as per the report received.

The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai, Dhemaji & Sisiborgaon under Dhemaji district; Nazira, Sonari & Mahmora under Sivasagar district; Samaguri, Nagaon Sadar & Hojai under Nagaon district; Jorhat West under Jorhat district and Narayanpur under Lakhimpur district. Flood has been reported from 116 Villages & 11 Revenue circles.

According to CWC reports, following rivers are flowing above danger level: River Dhansiri (south) at Numaligarh (Golaghat), Dikhow at Sivasagar, Deshang at Nangalamura (Sivasagar) and Kathasal at Matijuri (Hailakandi).
