**Flood bulletin as on 19<sup>th</sup> August, 2013**

As on today, 28074 population in four districts i.e. Dhemaji, Golaghat, Nagaon, & Sivasagar have been affected by flood. Thirty five (35) relief camps in Sivasagar, Nagaon & Dhemaji district are operational with 11028 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 9 Revenue Circles & 84 Villages. The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai under Dhemaji district; Demow, Nazira, Sonari & Mahmora under Sivasagar district, Dergaon under Golaghat district; Samaguri, Nagaon Sadar, Hojai under Nagaon district.

As per CWC report, following rivers are flowing above danger level: Dhansiri (South) at Numaligarh, Dikhow at Sivasagar & Kathakhal at Matizuri (Hailakandi).
