Flood bulletin as on 20th August, 2013

As on today, 33197 population in four districts i.e. Dhemaji, Golaghat, Nagaon, & Sivasagar have been affected by flood. Sixteen (16) relief camps in Sivasagar, Nagaon & Dhemaji district are operational with 7592 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 9 Revenue Circles & 68 Villages. The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai under Dhemaji district; Demow, Nazira, Sonari & Mahmora under Sivasagar district, Dergaon under Golaghat district; Samaguri, Nagaon Sadar under Nagaon district & Katigorah under Cachar district.

As per CWC report, following rivers are flowing above danger level: Dhansiri (South) at Numaligarh, Desang at Nanglamura (Sivasagar) & Katakhal at Hailakandi.
