**Flood bulletin as on 21<sup>st</sup> July, 2013**

The flood situation in the state of Assam has improved as compared to yesterday. As on today, Dhemaji, Jorhat and Nagaon districts are affected by flood. A total of 13,130 people are affected in Dhemaji & Nagaon districts in 50 villages of 4 revenue circles. As reported by the district administration, Jorhat, only croplands have been submerged in 10 villages of Majuli revenue circle but affecting no population. Nine (9) relief camps in Dhemaji district are still operational with 2106 camp inmates.

The revenue circles affected are Dhemaji, Jonai and Sissiborgaon under Dhemaji district; Majuli under Jorhat district and Samguri under Nagaon district. A total of 41 villages and 9291 people have been affected in Dhemaji district & 9 villages and 3839 people still remain affected in Nagaon district.

As per CWC reports the rivers flowing above danger level are – **Brahmaputra** at Nematighat (Jorhat), **Dhansiri(south)** at Numaligarh & **Jia Bharali** at NT Rd. Xing (Sonitpur).
