Flood bulletin as on 21st August, 2013

As on today, 26,098 population in three districts i.e. Dhemaji, Nagaon, & Sivasagar have been affected by flood. Fourteen (14) relief camps in Sivasagar, Nagaon & Dhemaji district are operational with 3,063 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 10 Revenue Circles & 58 Villages. The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai under Dhemaji district; Demow, Nazira, Sonari, Sivasagar & Mahmora under Sivasagar district, Dergaon under Golaghat district; Samaguri, Nagaon Sadar under Nagaon district & Algapur under Hailakandi district.

As per CWC report, no rivers are flowing above danger level as on today.
