Flood bulletin as on 22nd July, 2013

Flood situation in the State has improved with two districts of Assam i.e. Dhemaji, & Nagaon being affected as on today. Number of affected population has also come down to 9,171 from 13,130 of the previous day & in Jorhat district only crop areas have been affected as reported by the concerned district administrations. Nine (9) relief camps in Dhemaji district are still operational with 2,227 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 5 revenue circles & 69 villages. The revenue circles affected are Dhemaji, Jonai and Sissiborgaon under Dhemaji district, Majuli under Jorhat district, Samaguri under Nagaon district. A total of 40 villages and 5332 people have been affected in Dhemaji district & 9 villages and 3839 people have been affected in Nagaon district.

As per CWC report, following rivers are flowing above danger levels- river Brahmaputra at Nematighat (Jorhat), river Dhansiri(South) at Numaligarh (Golaghat) & river Jiabharali at NT Road Xing (Sonitpur).
