Flood bulletin as on 23rd July, 2013

Population in three districts of Assam i.e. Dhemaji, Lakhimpur & Nagaon is being affected as on today & in Golaghat and Jorhat district only crop areas have been affected as reported by the concerned district administrations. Nine (9) relief camps in Dhemaji district are still operational with 2,273 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 7 revenue circles & 89 villages. The revenue circles affected are Dhemaji, Jonai and Sissiborgaon under Dhemaji district, Majuli under Jorhat district, Samaguri under Nagaon district, Golaghat under Golaghat district & Bihpuria under Lakhimpur district. A total of 35 villages and 4379 people have been affected in Dhemaji district & 9 villages and 3839 people have been affected in Nagaon district. In Bihpuria revenue circle of Lakhimpur district 20 villages and 17500 people have been affected, but no relief camps have been opened.

As per CWC report, following rivers are flowing above danger levels- river Brahmaputra at Nematighat (Jorhat), river Dhansiri(South) at Numaligarh (Golaghat) & river Beki at Road Bridge, Barpeta.
