**Flood bulletin as on 23<sup>rd</sup> August, 2013**

As on today, 7,373 population in four districts i.e. Dhemaji, Nagaon, Hailakandi & Sivasagar have been affected by flood. Nine (9) relief camps in Nagaon & Dhemaji district are operational with 1,367 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 8 Revenue Circles & 84 Villages. The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai under Dhemaji district; Nazira & Sivasagar under Sivasagar district; Samaguri, Nagaon Sadar under Nagaon district & Algapur, Lala and Hailakandi under Hailakandi district.

As per CWC report, no rivers are flowing above danger level as on today.
