Flood bulletin as on 25th August, 2013

As on today, 6,123 population in three districts i.e. Dhemaji, Nagaon & Hailakandi have been affected by flood. Eight (8) relief camps in Nagaon & Dhemaji district are operational with 1,167 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 6 Revenue Circles & 73 Villages. The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai under Dhemaji district; Samaguri, Nagaon Sadar under Nagaon district & Algapur, Lala and Hailakandi under Hailakandi district.

As per CWC report, river Dhansiri (South) is flowing above danger level at Numaligarh (Golaghat).
