

Flood bulletin as on 26th September, 2013

As on today, only Dhemaji with 11 villages under Jonai Revenue Circles are affected by flood with 225 Hecter area of cropland under inundation. A total of 2,501 people are still remain affected in the district with two (2) relief camps are operational with 792 camp inmates.

As per CWC reports no rivers are flowing above danger level as on today.
