Press Release by Assam State Disaster Management Authority (ASDMA)

Flood bulletin as on 28th August, 2013

As on today, 7922 population in three districts viz. Dhemaji, Golaghat & Hailakandi have been affected by flood. One (1) relief camp in Dhemaji district is operational with 452 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 3 Revenue Circles & 43 villages. The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai under Dhemaji district; Golaghat under Golaghat district & Algapur under Hailakandi district.

As per CWC report, river Dhansiri (South) at Numaligarh (Golaghat) and Kathakal river at Matizuri (Hailakandi) are flowing above danger level.
