As on today, Dhemaji district is affected by flood in 11 villages of Jonai Revenue Circles. Total of 2,501 nos. of people are still remain affected in Dhemaji district, while two (2) relief camps under Jonai Revenue Circle are operational with 792 camp inmates.

As per CWC reports no rivers are flowing above danger level as on today.
