Flood bulletin as on 29th July, 2013

Flood situation in the State has improved significantly in the last 24 hrs. As on today, 3673 population in two districts i.e. Dhemaji & Lakhimpur district is being affected & in Golaghat and Jorhat district only crop areas have been affected as reported by the concerned district administrations. Nine (9) relief camps in Dhemaji district are still operational with 2227camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 8 revenue circles & 50 villages. The revenue circles affected are Dhemaji, Jonai and Sissiborgaon under Dhemaji district; Majuli, West Jorhat and Teok under Jorhat district; Golaghat under Golaghat district & Kadam under Lakhimpur district. A total of 19 villages and 2648 people (in Jonai revenue circle only) have been affected in Dhemaji district & 2 villages and 1025 people have been affected in Lakhimpur district.

As per CWC report, following rivers are flowing above danger levels- river Brahmaputra at Nematighat (Jorhat) & river Dhansiri (South) at Numaligarh (Golaghat).
