Flood bulletin as on 30th August, 2013

As on today, 10,574 population in three districts i.e. Dhemaji, Golaghat & Hailakandi have been affected by flood. One (1) relief camps in Dhemaji district is operational with 452 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 5 Revenue Circles & 79 Villages. The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai, Sisiborgaon & Dhemaji under Dhemaji district, Golaghat under Golaghat ditrict & Algapur under Hailakandi district.

As per CWC report, following rivers are flowing above danger level: Dhansiri (South) at Numaligarh (Golaghat) & river Jia Bharali at NT rd. Xing Sonitpur.
