**Press Release by Assam State Disaster Management Authority (ASDMA)**

**Flood bulletin as on 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2013**

As on today, 10,851 population in four districts i.e. Dhemaji, Golaghat, Lakhimpur & Hailakandi have been affected by flood. One (1) relief camps in Dhemaji district is operational with 452 camp inmates.

Flood has been reported from 6 Revenue Circles & 70 Villages. The Revenue Circles affected are Jonai, Sisiborgaon & Dhemaji under Dhemaji district; Subansiri under Lakhimpur district; Golaghat under Golaghat ditrict & Algapur under Hailakandi district.

As per CWC report, river Dhansiri (South) is flowing above danger level at Numaligarh (Golaghat).
