ORDERS BY THE GOVERNOR OF ASSAM

NOTIFICATION

Dated Dispur, the December, 2022

ECF No. 227624: Consequent upon the approval of the cabinet on September 11, 2022, the Governor of Assam is pleased to notify the Assam Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) Roadmap 2030 ,which is published on the website of Assam State Disaster Management Authority at www.asdma.gov.in. The roadmap will accomplish the following objectives through a coordinated action with the departments of the government of Assam:

1. To promote policy coherence relevant to disaster risk reduction,sustainable development, gender equity, poverty reduction and climate change, particularly with the SDGs and the Paris Climate Agreement, Prime Minister's Ten Point Agenda for DRR and National Disaster Management Plan of India, 2019.
2. To establish realistic targets in alignment with Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction (SFDRR) for reduction of losses and impacts.
3. To set realistic and feasible actions across short, medium and longer timescales in alignment with the four priority areas of SFDRR for achieving the defined targets with a focus on the most vulnerable groups including women, children. differently abled, families living below the poverty line.
4. To identify the strategic opportunities for stakeholders (Government, Civil Society Organizations, Academic Institutions. Private Sector and UN Agencies) to coordinate and collaborate for disaster risk reduction

actions.

5. To establish a multi-stakeholder mechanism to follow-up, periodically assess and publicly report on progress.
6. To estimate the average sector-wise losses and impacts due to disasters in the state of Assam from 2011 onward, based on available data.

Departmental Roles and Responsibilities

Each department shall have to ensure some non-negotiable or mandatory action which includes the preparation of the Departmental Disaster Management Plan (DDMP), maintenance of database necessary for action, hazard analysis, vulnerability assessment, departmental budgeting, issuance of orders for safety audits, awareness generation & remedial action and other necessary structural & non-structural measures. In principle and practice all the departments shall ensure the mandatory integration of DRR and Climate Change adaptation measures in relevant departmental planning, designing & implementation of projects & schemes. Every department shall integrate DRR Roadmap interventions in each of their programme initiatives which should explicitly be visualized in their departmental disaster management plan.

The endeavor of DRR Roadmap is to achieve total resilience with following specific attributes:
